**INGREDIENTS**

Processed grain by-products, roughage products (30%), cane molasses, grain products, calcium carbonate, dicalcium phosphate, salt.

**FEEDING DIRECTIONS**

**CATTLE:** Feed 1 to 2 lb per 100 lb of body weight per head per day to beef cattle on pasture. Provide a source of fresh, clean water at all times along with a quality mineral supplement such as Lone Star Kal-Phos 12-12 Mineral Supplement.

**HORSES:** Feed 1 to 1½ lb per 100 lb of body weight per head per day with adequate good quality hay or grazing. Do not feed free choice or exceed the recommended feeding rate. Feed at regular times at least twice daily. Provide a source of fresh, clean water at all times.

**CAUTION:** Changes in feed should be made gradually. Feed should be stored in a well-ventilated, dry area that is protected from rodents and insects. Feed is perishable. Do not feed moldy or insect-infested feed as it may cause illness or death.
