FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Feed free choice in covered feeders to beef cattle. Provide plenty of good quality hay or pasture free choice along with a supply of fresh, clean water.

CAUTION: For ruminants only. Do not feed to horses, mules, colts, ponies, or hogs. Changes in feed should be made gradually. Feed should be stored in a well-ventilated, dry area that is protected from rodents and insects. Feed is perishable. Do not feed moldy or insect-infested feed as it may cause illness or death.
