FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Feed to beef cattle on pasture at the rate of 2 to 5 pounds per head per day. Feeding rate is determined by pasture condition and stage of production of animals. Distribute cubes on ground in order to assure uniform consumption. Provide a source of fresh, clean water at all times.

CAUTION: For ruminants only. Do not feed to horses, mules, colts, ponies, or hogs. Feed should be stored in a well-ventilated, dry area that is protected from rodents and insects. Feed is perishable. Do not feed moldy or insect-infested feed to animals as it may cause illness or death.
