INGREDIENTS

Processed grain by-products, plant protein products, grain products, salt, cane molasses, dicalcium phosphate, calcium carbonate, magnesium oxide, vitamin A acetate, D-activated animal sterol (source of vitamin D3), vitamin E supplement, sodium selenite, manganese sulfate, zinc methionine complex, zinc sulfate, ferrous sulfate, copper sulfate, ethylenediamine dihydriodide, cobalt carbonate.

FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Feed free choice in covered feeders to horses, beef cattle, and dairy cattle. Provide plenty of good quality hay or pasture along with a supply of fresh, clean water.

CAUTION: Changes in feed should be made gradually. Feed should be stored in a well-ventilated, dry area that is protected from rodents and insects. Feed is perishable. Do not feed moldy or insect-infested feed as it may cause illness or death.
