FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Feed at the rate of 1.2 to 6 pounds per head per day to beef cattle on pasture. This will provide a minimum of 60 mg of lasalocid per head per day and a maximum of 300 mg per head per day. Provide a source of fresh, clean water at all times.

WARNING: A withdrawal period has not been established for this product in pre-ruminating cattle. Do not use in calves to be processed for veal.

CAUTION: The safety of Lasalocid for use in unapproved species has not been established. Do not allow horses or other equines access to feeds containing Lasalocid as ingestion may be fatal. Feed should be stored in a well-ventilated, dry area that is protected from rodents and insects. Feed is perishable.
