INGREDIENTS

Meat and bone meal, ground yellow corn, ground wheat, rice bran, poultry fat (preserved with mixed tocopherols and ascorbyl palmitate), poultry by-product meal, beet pulp, flaxseed, natural chicken flavor, salt, vitamin A supplement, vitamin D3 supplement, vitamin E supplement, vitamin B12 supplement, riboflavin supplement, DL-methionine, niacin, calcium pantothenate, choline chloride, menadione sodium bisulfite complex (source of vitamin K activity), folic acid, biotin, thiamine mononitrate, pyridoxine hydrochloride, sodium selenite, calcium iodate, ferrous sulfate, manganese sulfate, zinc sulfate, copper sulfate.

FEEDING SUGGESTIONS

Adult Dogs: The amount of food required each day will vary by breed, activity level, temperament, and climate, and should be adjusted accordingly using the chart below as a guide. In most cases, once-a-day feeding is sufficient. If your dog prefers twice-a-day feeding, feed 1/2 of the daily amount in the morning and the other 1/2 in the afternoon. If preferred, one part warm water can be added to three parts Star Pro immediately before serving.

WEIGHT OF DOG	DAILY AMOUNT*
Up to 12 lb	Up to 1/2 cup
12 - 25 lb	1/2 - 11/4 cups
25 - 50 lb	1 ¹ / ₄ - 2 ¹ / ₄ cups
50 - 75 lb	2 ¹ / ₄ - 3 ¹ / ₄ cups
75 - 100 lb	31/4 - 4 cups
Over 100 lb. add 1	cup for each 25 lb of weight.

*One standard 8-oz measuring cup holds approx. 4 ounces of food.

Puppies: Start puppies on moistened Star Pro as soon as they begin to nibble on solid food (usually 3 to 5 weeks of age). While they continue nursing, keep moistened Star Pro available at all times until fully weaned at 6 to 8 weeks of age. After weaning, Star Pro may be fed moist or dry. Feed puppies up to 6 months of age all of the Star Pro they can consume. If fed dry, Star Pro may be kept before puppies at all times.

Gestation and Lactation: Consumption will vary; therefore, feed the amount required to maintain good body condition. Food may need to be available at all times.

Water: Provide a source of fresh, clean water at all times.

CAUTION: Changes in pet food should be made gradually. Pet food should be stored in a well-ventilated, dry area protected from rodents and insects. Pet food is perishable. Do not feed moldy or insect-infested pet food to animals as it may cause illness or death.
