INGREDIENTS

FEEDING DIRECTIONS


The recommended feeding rate for Track Star Senior is shown in the chart below. Do not feed free choice. Provide plenty of good quality pasture along with a source of fresh, clean water. If you feed by dry measure, periodically weigh the daily feed to ensure that the proper amount is being fed. Observe the condition of your horse over a period of time. The recommended feeding rates may be increased or decreased to keep your horse in the desired condition. Changes in feed or feeding rate should be made gradually over several days. Changes in feeding rate should not exceed 1 pound per day. Feed at regular times at least twice daily. If horse is hot, excited, or ill, delay feeding. Do not allow horse to over-consume or eat rapidly. An effective internal parasite control program is essential to your horse's health. Observe your horse's condition regularly. Consult your veterinarian if any problems arise.

DAILY FEEDING CHART

WEIGHT OF HORSE	800	1000	1200
Track Star Senior (min. lb/day)			
Maintenance	10-12	12-14	14-16
Light Work	12-14	14-16	16-18

Good quality hay may be fed along with Track Star Senior. The amount of feed can be reduced by approximately 1 pound for every 2 pounds of hay.

In cases of extreme dental problems, Track Star Senior may be soaked with warm water to form a mash. Allow to soak for several minutes until feed is in desired consistency.



CAUTION: Changes in feed should be made gradually. Feed should be stored in a well-ventilated, dry area that is protected from rodents and insects. Feed is perishable. Do not feed moldy or insect-infested feed as it may cause illness or death.
