INGREDIENTS

Ground yellow corn, meat and bone meal, corn gluten meal, soybean meal, chicken fat (preserved with mixed tocopherols), natural flavor, brewers rice, dried beet pulp, flaxseed, fish oil, salt, monocalcium phosphate, choline chloride, zinc proteinate, copper proteinate, manganese proteinate, iron proteinate, zinc sulfate, ferrous sulfate, vitamin E supplement, niacin, copper sulfate, manganese sulfate, vitamin A supplement, calcium pantothenate, biotin, vitamin B12 supplement, pyridoxine hydrochloride (source of vitamin B6), thiamine mononitrate (source of vitamin B1), menadione sodium bisulfite complex (source of vitamin K activity), calcium iodate, vitamin D3 supplement, riboflavin supplement (source of vitamin B2), folic acid, sodium selenite, DL-methionine.

FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Puppies begin to eat solid food at 3-4 weeks of age. Keep Lone Star® Puppy Food available to your puppies at all times. If water is added, use no more than one part warm (not hot) liquid to three parts Puppy Food, changing frequently to ensure freshness. After weaning at six to eight weeks of age, puppies will normally eat dry or moistened food at will. Feed very young puppies three times a day, older puppies twice a day. Use the recommended daily feeding chart provided as a guide. Feed to maintain ideal body condition. Slight appetite changes and occasional digestive upsets are normal in puppies. If upsets become severe or linger longer than a day or two, contact your veterinarian.

Lone Star® Puppy Food is easy to feed. No need to add anything for taste or nutrition.

GESTATION & LACTATION: Lone Star® Puppy Food provides the extra nutrition needed by reproducing females in stages of gestation and lactation. Food consumption may vary during gestation, so feed the amount needed to maintain the pregnant female's good body condition. Food intake may double or even quadruple during lactation.

SWITCHING TO LONE STAR PUPPY FOOD: Changes in your pet's feeding habits should be made gradually. When changing over to Lone Star® Puppy Food, first substitute small amounts of dog's current food. Then over the next week to 10 days, increase the amounts of Puppy Food while decreasing amounts of the other food, until your pet's diet contains 100% Puppy Food.

WATER: Provide your puppy with plenty of fresh water in a clean container daily. For your pet's health, see your veterinarian regularly. Store in a cool dry place. Wash hands after handling dog food.
